Channel 5 with other industry leaders is actively participating in the ScreenSkills Unscripted TV Skills Fund as part of our commitment to develop learning skills within the TV industry.

This participation involves equal contributions from broadcasters and producers of commissioned Unscripted programming at the rate of 0.125% each, totalling 0.25% of the Channel 5 Licence Fee.

In accordance with our agreement with ScreenSkills and notice to you on approval of your commission, Channel 5 will make a deduction from your final milestone payment at the producer rate of 0.125%.

Qualifying Unscripted TV Production on all UK originations commissioned by Channel 5 within the following Ofcom categories:

- Current Affairs
- Factual
- Arts and Classical Music
- Religion and Ethics
- Education
- Entertainment & Contemporary Music
- Sports (Production only)

The producer's final invoice to the Broadcaster must identify the total ScreenSkills Deduction as set out in the Cash Flow within Appendix B of the Programme Production Agreement.
